Personal Care

Do you need assistance with showering or other hygiene-related tasks? Would you like to “top up” the services you receive as part of a government funded care package? If the answer is “yes” to either of these questions, our qualified Caring Choice care workers can assist.

Personal care can include assistance with:

Showering We provide assistance with showering as required. This may include helping with “difficult to reach” areas of the body and drying. We can provide “stand-by” assistance that gives our clients the confidence to shower, in the knowledge that someone is there to assist in the event of a mishap.

Dressing assistance We can help with pressure stockings, shoes and socks – or anything that causes difficulty.

Grooming We can assist with brushing teeth, hair and even shaving.

Dementia Care

Caring Choice have demonstrated expertise in the provision of dementia care – offering support to the client, their families and loved ones. Dementia care is extremely varied and may include:

Respite for family Carers through the provision of a qualified Care Worker to monitor the client with dementia.

Diversional Therapy A client-centered practice that encourages leisure and recreational experiences for dementia clients. Through an emphasis on holistic care, we provide physical, psychological, social, intellectual and spiritual/cultural support to the client.

Check Visits

Sometime a quick visit to a frail, aged client or client with dementia from a friendly face may be all that they need to live at home independently. Such visits may include prompting for meals, showering and/or medication.

Respite Care

Respite is a term that means “taking a break” and can be essential to the physical and mental well-being of a family carer. It’s important for you to enjoy some time out knowing that your loved one will be cared for by someone with the right experience. Respite can be arranged whenever it’s required, or on a regular basis.

Meal Preparation

Assistance with preparing, cooking and making meals.

Social Outings and Companionship

Regular visits can help alleviate loneliness and take pressure off busy families – or families that live interstate or overseas. Companionship visits can take place in the home of the client.
